THE OVERVIEW

Left to Right Kanchenjunga Trek is actually worthwhile which tenders' incredible scenery, striking panorama and white snow-covered Mountains. As a Nepal Tours in these areas, you can play in elevated snow peaks which cross above 8,000 meters. and some below 8,000 meters. Trekking in Nepal brings extraordinary setting that is superb for photography. Wild animals like Musk Deer, Snow leopard, Red Panda. and many other animals are found on this trekking trail. The trek will proceed from Kanchenjunga Conservation Area which automatically lets you view the wide diverse flora and fauna. Kanchenjunga Trek can be carried out either from the South...

01

Arrival in Kathmandu

Arrive in Kathmandu and transfer to your hotel. Spend the night in the capital, preparing for the trek ahead.

ALT: 1,450m MEAL: Dinner

02

Fly from Kathmandu to Taplejung, then Drive to Chiruwa

After breakfast, you will take a scenic flight from Kathmandu to Taplejung. Once at Taplejung, you will drive to Chiruwa by jeep, the starting point of your trek. This will be your first introduction to the stunning landscapes of the Kanchenjunga region.

ALT: 1,190m MEAL: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

03

Trek from Chiruwa to Sake Thung

Start your trek with a gradual ascent through dense forests of rhododendron and oak trees. You will pass by traditional villages and enjoy the scenic beauty as you reach Sake Thung, a peaceful village set among the hills.

ALT: 1,640m HIKE: 5-6 hours MEAL: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

04

Trek from Sake Thung to Amjilosa

The trek today takes you through forests and valleys, crossing several small streams and waterfalls along the way. You will reach Amjilosa, where you can relax and enjoy the beautiful surroundings.

ALT: 2,490m HIKE: 5-6 hours MEAL: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

05

Trek from Amjilosa to Gyabla

Continue your trek along a well-defined trail. As you ascend, you will witness changing landscapes, with magnificent mountain views along the way. Gyabla is a village set in a tranquil environment, offering stunning views of the surrounding peaks.

ALT: 2,730m HIKE: 5-6 hours MEAL: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

06

Trek from Gyabla to Ghunsa

This day involves a steady climb through forests, offering glimpses of the spectacular mountain vistas. Upon reaching Ghunsa, you will be able to see the stunning views of the Kanchenjunga range.

ALT: 3,410m HIKE: 5-6 hours MEAL: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

07

Acclimatization Day in Ghunsa

A rest day in Ghunsa to help your body adjust to the altitude. You can explore the village, interact with locals, and take a short hike around the area for acclimatization.

ALT: 3,410m MEAL: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

08

Trek from Ghunsa to Khambachen

Begin your trek from Ghunsa and ascend to the higher altitude of Khambachen. The views of the snow-capped peaks and glaciers will become more prominent as you climb. This is a challenging day, but the reward is worth it.

ALT: 4,140m HIKE: 6-7 hours MEAL: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

09

Trek from Khambachen to Lhonk

Continue trekking along the challenging trail that gradually ascends to Lhonk, where the views of the Kanchenjunga peaks become even more magnificent. You will also pass by glaciers and moraines, adding to the excitement of the journey.

ALT: 4,750m HIKE: 5-6 hours MEAL: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

10

Trek from Lhonk to Pang Pema Base Camp

This is a significant day as you reach the base camp of Kanchenjunga North. The scenery is breathtaking, with views of the surrounding peaks and glaciers. It's an essential point of the trek for those wanting to experience the full grandeur of Kanchenjunga.

ALT: 5,150m HIKE: 6-7 hours MEAL: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

11

Trek back to Khambachen

After spending time at Pang Pema Base Camp, you will trek back to Khambachen, retracing your steps. This allows your body to acclimatize and gradually descend to lower altitudes.

ALT: 4,140m HIKE: 5-6 hours MEAL: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

12

Trek back to Ghunsa

Retrace your steps from Khambachen to Ghunsa, enjoying the scenery in reverse. This part of the trek is less strenuous, as it involves descending to lower altitudes.

ALT: 3,410m HIKE: 5-6 hours MEAL: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

13

Trek from Ghunsa to Amjilosa

Continue your descent as you trek back down to Amjilosa. The views along the way are stunning, offering opportunities for photography and peaceful moments in nature.

ALT: 2,490m HIKE: 5-6 hours MEAL: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

14

Trek from Amjilosa to Chiruwa

On the final stretch of the trek, descend from Amjilosa to Chiruwa, where your trekking journey in the Kanchenjunga region will come to an end.

ALT: 1,190m HIKE: 5-6 hours MEAL: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

15

Drive from Chiruwa to Tumlingtar, then Flight to Kathmandu

Drive to Tumlingtar and catch a flight back to Kathmandu. Spend your last night in Nepal in comfort before departing for home.

ALT: 1,400m MEAL: Breakfast, Dinner

16

Departure from Kathmandu

Transfer to the airport for your departure flight.

ALT: 1,440m MEAL: Breakfast
