THE OVERVIEW

Lobuche Peak Climbing is one of the most challenging and rewarding trekking peak adventures in the Everest region of Nepal. Rising to an altitude of 6,119 meters, Lobuche Peak is located close to Mount Everest and offers climbers dramatic panoramic views of Everest, Lhotse, Nuptse, Ama Dablam, Pumori, and surrounding glaciers. Compared to other trekking peaks, Lobuche Peak demands stronger technical skills and physical endurance, making it ideal for experienced trekkers and climbers looking for a serious Himalayan challenge. The expedition follows the classic Everest Base Camp trail before branching toward Lobuche Base Camp. The climb involves glacier travel, steep...

01

Arrival in Kathmandu

Arrive at Tribhuvan International Airport in Kathmandu where our team will receive you and transfer you to your hotel. After check-in, you can rest or explore nearby areas. In the evening, you'll meet the expedition leader for a briefing about the Lobuche Peak climb.

02

Climbing Preparation and Equipment Check

Today is reserved for checking all climbing equipment and final expedition preparations. Your guide will inspect personal gear and provide advice on missing or rental items. A detailed briefing on safety, route, and acclimatization will be given.

ALT: 1,400m MEAL: Breakfast

03

Fly to Lukla and Trek to Phakding

Early morning flight to Lukla, one of the most scenic flights in the world. After landing, begin trekking through Sherpa villages and pine forests along the Dudh Koshi River to Phakding.

ALT: 2,600m HIKE: 3–4 hours MEAL: B, L, D

04

Trek to Namche Bazaar

The trail follows the Dudh Koshi River, crossing several suspension bridges including the famous Hillary Bridge. A steady uphill climb brings you to Namche Bazaar, the main trading center of the Everest region.

ALT: 3,440m HIKE: 5–6 hours MEAL: B, L, D

05

Acclimatization Day at Namche

This day is essential for acclimatization. You'll hike to Everest View Hotel and nearby Sherpa villages like Khumjung and Kunde, enjoying stunning views of Everest, Lhotse, and Ama Dablam before returning to Namche.

ALT: 3,440m HIKE: 3–4 hours MEAL: B, L, D

06

Trek to Tengboche

Trek along scenic ridges with panoramic mountain views before descending to the river and climbing again to Tengboche. Visit the famous Tengboche Monastery, the spiritual heart of the Khumbu region.

ALT: 3,860m HIKE: 5–6 hours MEAL: B, L, D

07

Trek to Dingboche

Continue trekking through alpine landscapes along the Imja Valley. The vegetation becomes sparse as altitude increases, and stunning views of Lhotse and Island Peak surround Dingboche.

ALT: 4,410m HIKE: 5–6 hours MEAL: B, L, D

08

Acclimatization Day at Dingboche

Another important acclimatization day. You'll take a short hike to nearby ridges for altitude adjustment and return to Dingboche to rest and prepare for higher elevations.

ALT: 4,410m HIKE: 3–4 hours MEAL: B, L, D

09

Trek to Lobuche Village

The trail climbs gradually past memorials dedicated to climbers who lost their lives in the Himalayas. You'll trek along glacial moraines with dramatic views of Nuptse and surrounding peaks before reaching Lobuche.

ALT: 4,910m HIKE: 4–5 hours MEAL: B, L, D

10

Trek to Lobuche Base Camp

Leave the main trail and head toward Lobuche Base Camp. The terrain becomes rocky and rugged as you cross glacier sections and moraines, entering a true expedition environment.

ALT: 5,000m HIKE: 4–5 hours MEAL: B, L, D

11

Acclimatization and Climbing Training

A full day for rest and technical training. Your climbing Sherpa will teach rope techniques, ice axe use, crampon skills, and fixed-rope climbing to prepare for summit day.

ALT: 5,000m HIKE: 2–3 hours MEAL: B, L, D

12

Trek to High Camp

Climb gradually toward High Camp over steep snow and rocky terrain. This is a physically demanding day but crucial for positioning closer to the summit. Early rest is essential for summit day.

ALT: 5,400m HIKE: 4–5 hours MEAL: B, L, D

13

Summit Lobuche Peak

Start before dawn for the summit push. Climb steep snow and ice slopes using fixed ropes to reach the summit of Lobuche Peak. Enjoy incredible panoramic views before descending carefully back to base camp.

ALT: 6,119m HIKE: 8–9 hours MEAL: B, L, D

14

Trek to Pangboche

Descend from base camp to Pangboche, enjoying warmer air and lower altitude. The trail offers peaceful views of alpine valleys and traditional Sherpa villages.

ALT: 3,930m HIKE: 5–6 hours MEAL: B, L, D

15

Trek to Namche Bazaar

Continue descending through familiar trails, passing monasteries and forests. Celebrate the success of the climb as you return to Namche Bazaar.

ALT: 3,440m HIKE: 6–7 hours MEAL: B, L, D

16

Trek to Lukla

Final trekking day back to Lukla. Spend the evening celebrating the completion of the Lobuche Peak expedition with your team.

ALT: 2,850m HIKE: 6–7 hours MEAL: B, L, D

17

Fly to Ramechhap and Drive to Kathmandu

Fly from Lukla to Ramechhap and continue by road to Kathmandu. Transfer to your hotel and relax after the expedition.

ALT: 1,400m MEAL: Breakfast

18

Departure

Transfer to the international airport for your onward journey. End of the Lobuche Peak Climbing adventure.

ALT: 1,400m MEAL: Breakfast
